The mission of The Women's Center is to *provide safety, shelter, and support to empower all impacted by domestic abuse, sexual violence, child abuse, and trafficking*. All of our services are offered at no cost and include: emergency shelter & 24-hour Hotline; legal advocacy; family counseling; domestic violence, sexual assault and abuse counseling and support groups for adults and children; employment counseling and life-skills development; substance abuse and mental health support; transitional living; community education and violence prevention; and free on-site childcare for clients utilizing any of these services. *The Women's Center is Waukesha County's only resource* for those who are impacted by domestic and sexual violence.

Every April, we observe Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM) to raise public awareness about sexual violence and how we, as a community, can come together to address this pervasive crime. Join us in our work to support survivors by believing them and affirming their experience.
